Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Englander - Buscaino):

INSTRUCT the Bureau of Street Services to develop and implement the necessary actions to abate the pooling of stagnant water at the following locations in Council District 12.

- a. Intersection of Zelzah Avenue and Kinzie Street near California State University Northridge.
- b. South side of Kinzie Street and White Oak Street.
- c. 18689 Horace Street (Horace Street and Celtic Avenue).
- d. Corner of Canby Avenue and Blackhawk Street.
- e. 17918 Raymer Street.
- f. Intersection of Devonshire Street and Oso Avenue.
- g. 9612 Shoshone Avenue.

SUMMARY
