TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to amending the Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) to allow the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT) to delegate its authority to the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Metro) for the installation and removal of temporary traffic control devices.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Hutt – Padilla):

REQUEST the City Attorney to:

- 1. Negotiate and draft an amendment to the Master Cooperative Agreement for the Design and Construction of Transportation Projects (MCA), with the assistance of relevant departments, between Metro and the City of Los Angeles, to support implementation of the proposed amendment to LAMC Section 80.07.
- 2. Prepare and present an ordinance amending LAMC Section 80.07, with the assistance of the LADOT, in order to effectuate the MCA amendment, authorizing the LADOT to delegate its authority to Metro for the installation and removal of temporary traffic control devices. The ordinance amendment shall require indemnification of the City of Los Angeles from all liability resulting from Metro's installation and removal of temporary traffic control devices, a sunset provision, and project-specific approval.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On August 13, 2025, your Transportation Committee considered an August 1, 2025 Motion (Hutt – Padilla) amending the LAMC to allow the LADOT to delegate its authority to Metro for the installation and removal of temporary traffic control devices. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend approval of the Motion recommendations. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
