Circulators have claimed that the referendum would increase worker wages when it would actually eliminate a minimum wage increase.

The use of violence by circulators to prevent public education is unacceptable, and signatures obtained by misrepresenting the content of the petition do not represent the will of the voter. As the very petition process has been corrupted, we urge you to keep the measure off the ballot. At the very least, referendum petition signatures gathered by circulators who broke the law must be excluded.

-I encountered twice two petitioners who misinformed me that this was to help workers to keep the increased wages. When I questioned and asked who was sponsoring them, they became aggresive towards me and accused me of impeding them with earning a wage for collecting signatures.
