I personally experienced this when I went to the farmers market with my boyfriend, and we encountered a petitioner with this referendum petition. My boyfriend signed this referendum petition because the petitioner told him it would "help workers". I inquired further, "how does this petition help workers?" And the petitioner started stuttering because he didn't know how to explain. The more I questioned him the more I realized the petition was seeking to overturn the recent Olympic tourism industry wage increase victory, which I have been following and supporting, and asked again how overturning a minimum wage increase would help workers. The petitioner started admitting he didn't really understand the petition he was circling, finally claiming that the wage increase would "take away wages from workers in other industries," which is a blatant lie. My boyfriend asked to cross out his signature but the petitioner said "then I won't get paid" and AVOIDED GIVING THE PETITION BACK TO HIM. This was a deceptive experience and showed me that the groups which organized and paid for this referendum petition were telling their petitioners to LIE, and claim this petition actually helps workers when it does the opposite.
