

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT and ORDINANCE FIRST CONSIDERATION relative to amending the Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) to require all firearms located in a residence to be kept in a locked container or disabled with a trigger lock.

Recommendation for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

PRESENT and ADOPT the accompanying ORDINANCE dated July 26, 2019 to amend LAMC Section 55.21 to require that all firearms located in a residence be kept in a locked container or disabled with a trigger lock.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the City Attorney. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On August 14, 2019, your Committee considered a July 26, 2019 City Attorney report and Ordinance relative to amending LAMC Section 55.21 to require that all firearms located in a residence be kept in a locked container or disabled with a trigger lock. On June 5, 2019, Council requested the City Attorney to prepare and present an Ordinance to expand the City's Safe Storage Ordinance to include all firearms. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend approval of the Ordinance as detailed in the above recommendation. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
