It so happened that I became friends with Mr. and Mrs. Tanabe and I was made aware of their journey from their home in Northern California to Japanese Camp and after the war was over being totally destitute, their family moved to Los Angeles in hope of finding work since they has lost all they had.

I believe this proposed designation is long over due and it goes a long way to honor our Japanese American neighbors and acknowledge their contribution to this neighborhood.
