



Subject: Renaming of Community area as Japantown – CF 14-1686

The Bureau of Engineering has reviewed the application submitted to change the community name of a neighborhood in West Los Angeles. The application proposes renaming the neighborhood as Japantown.

There are approximately 3,050 properties with an estimated population of 16,323 people derived from the 2010 census. This community is a part of the 90025 and the 90064 zip codes and is solely within Council District 11. The community is found completely within both the Community Plan Area of West Los Angeles and the Neighborhood Council of West Los Angeles.

The attached maps shows the parcels within the proposed new community borders as shown on the application in relation to the boundaries of the Council Districts, Community Plan Areas, Neighborhood Councils, Census Tracts, and zip codes.

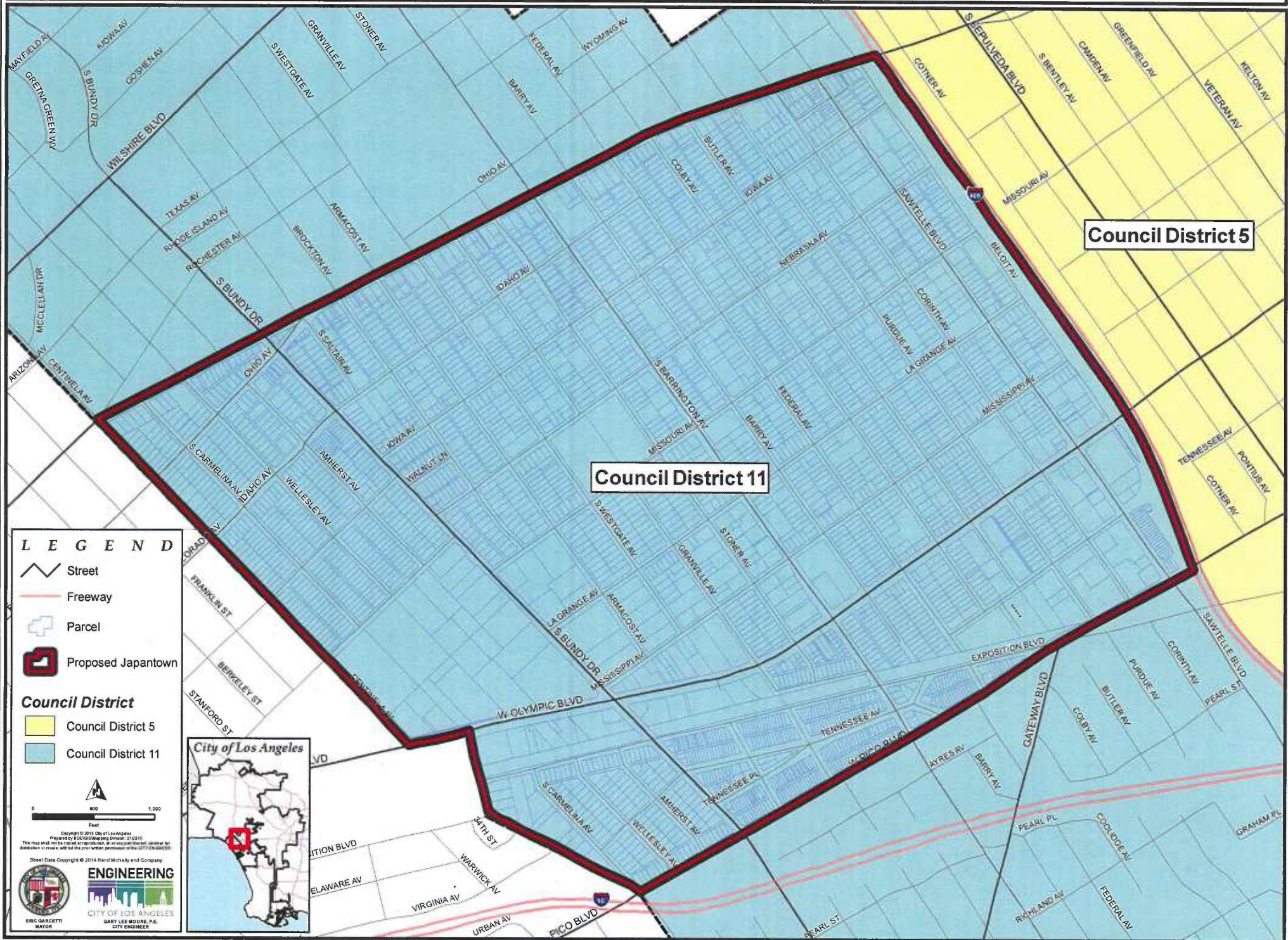
The Bureau of Engineering has no additional pertinent information concerning the historical use for this neighborhood in the community.

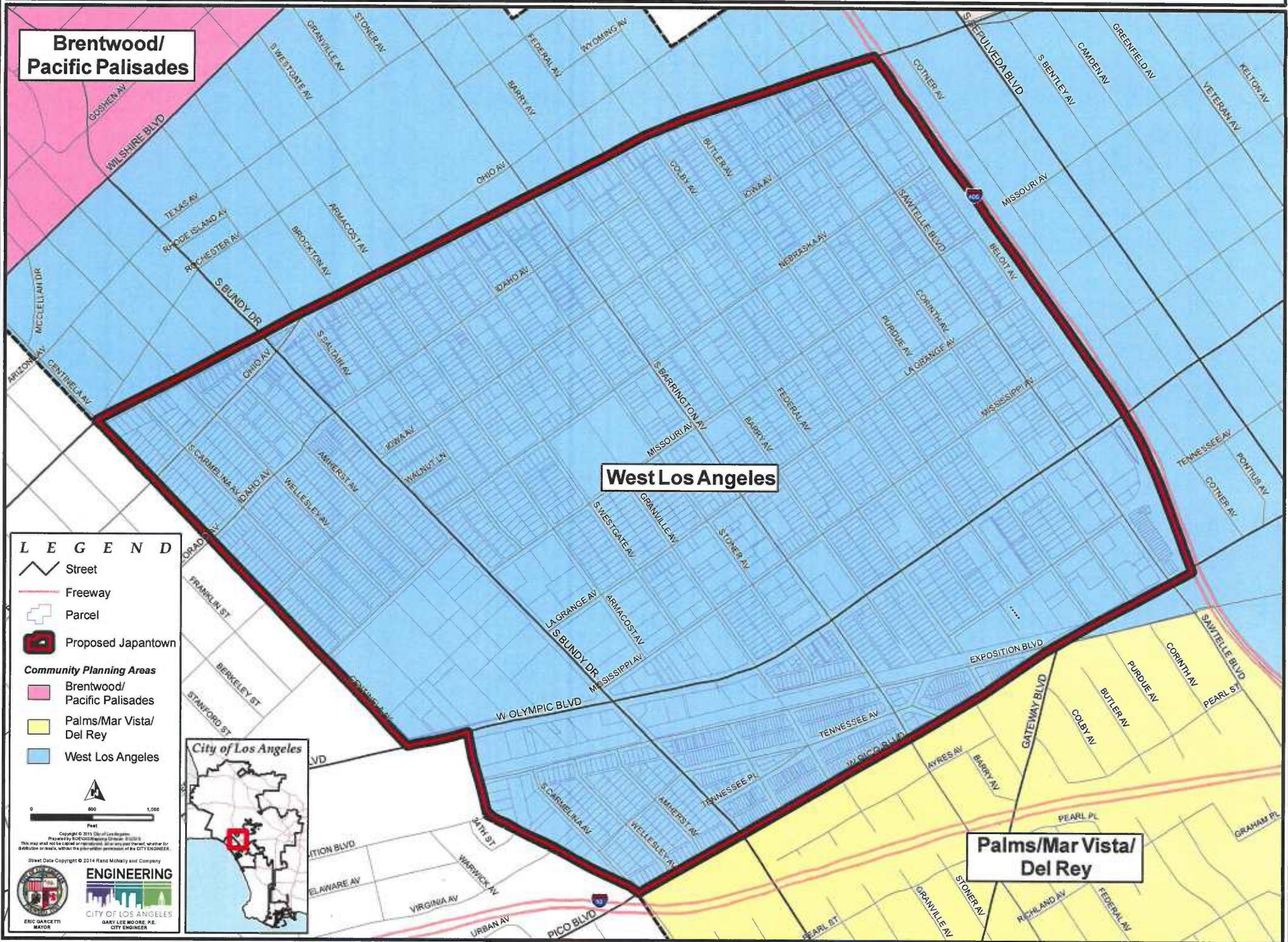

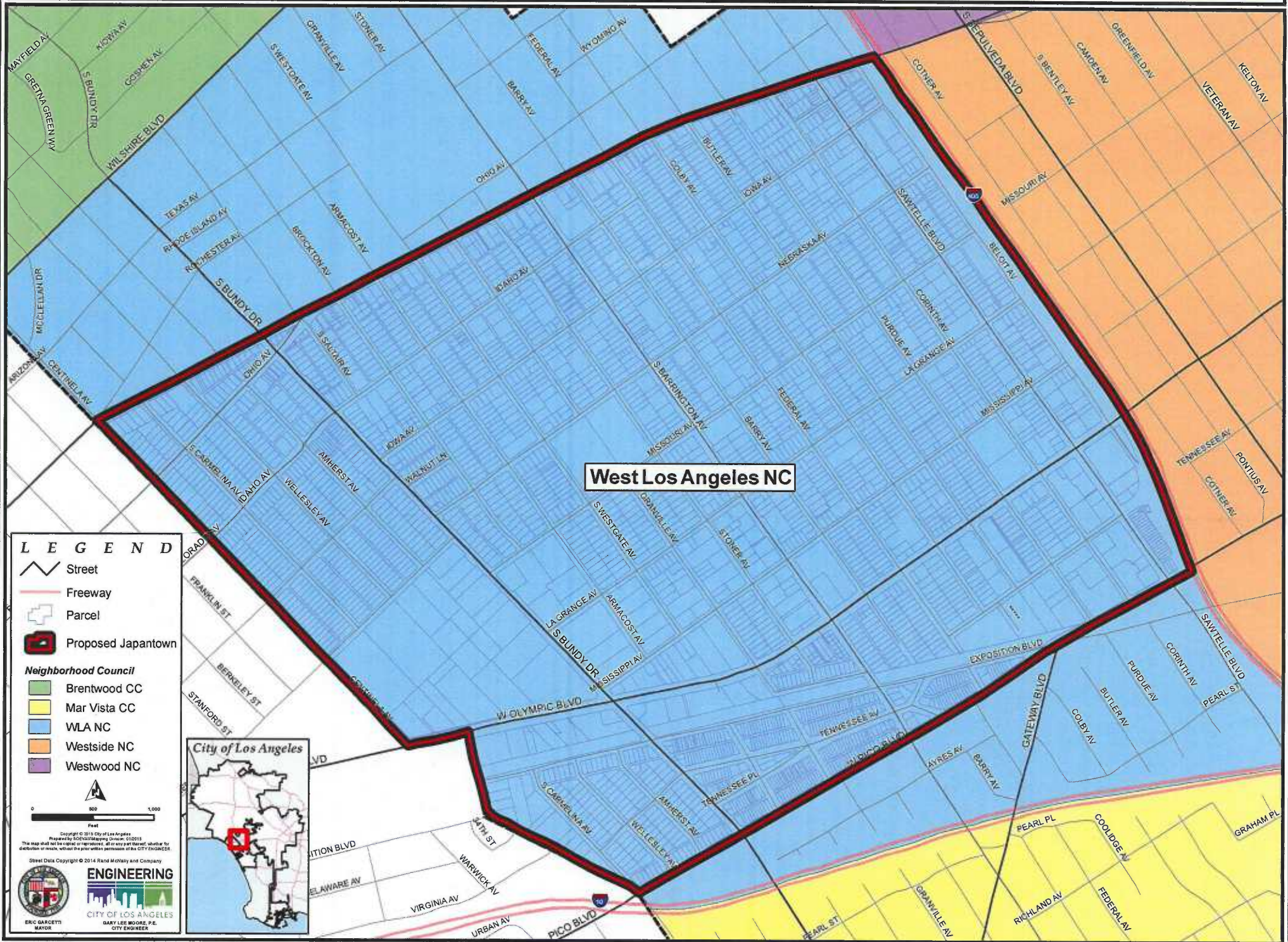
Japantown Neighborhood Area Council Districts



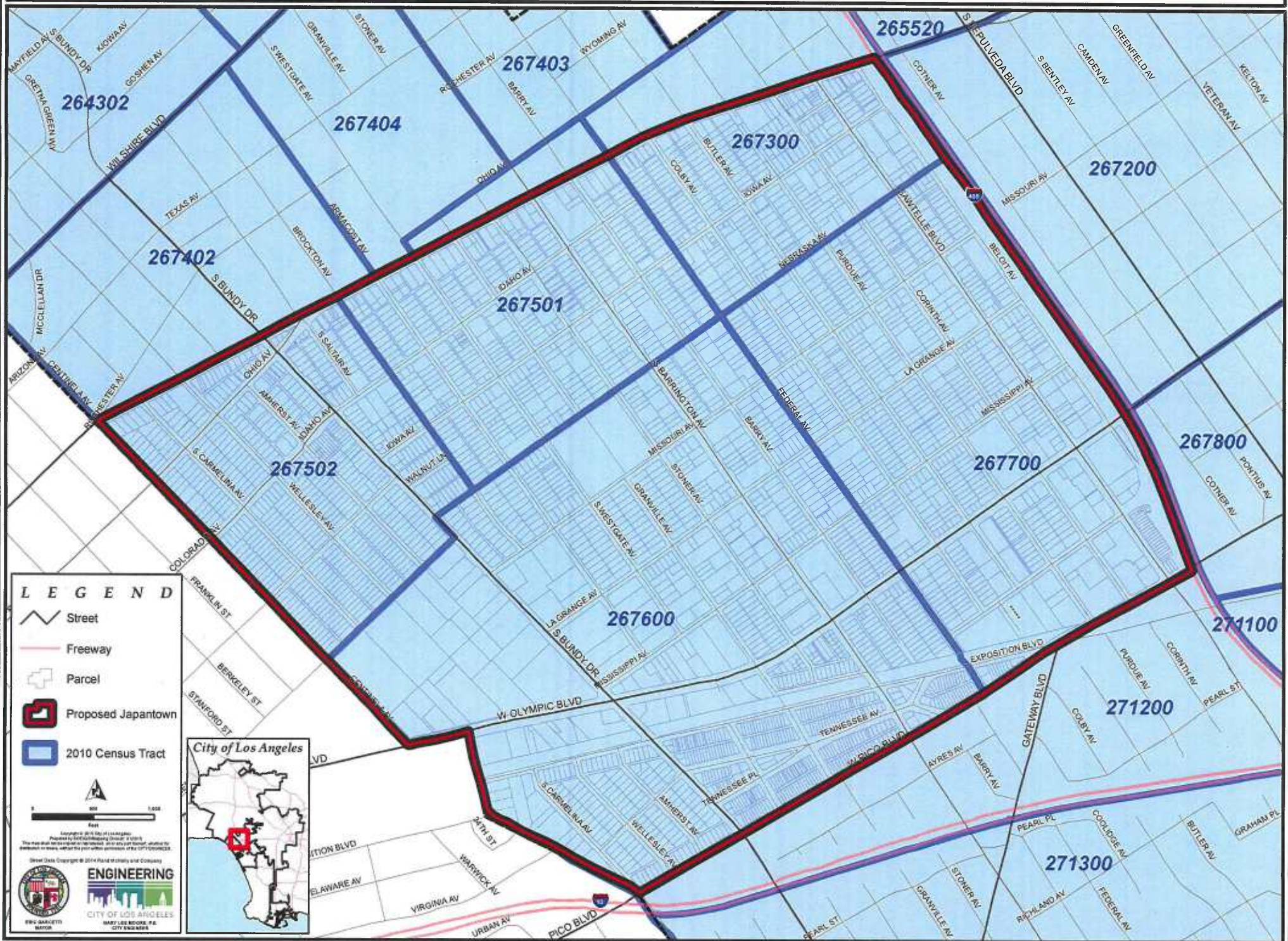
Japantown Neighborhood Area Community Plan Areas
