

RULES, ELECTIONS, INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS, AND NEIGHBORHOODS COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to establishing the City's position regarding legislation to lift restrictions on the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and National Institutes of Health (NIH) that prohibit them from conducting research on gun violence.

Recommendation for Council Action, pursuant to Resolution (Koretz - Krekorian), SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION to include in the City's 2015-16 Federal Legislative Program SUPPORT for legislation that would lift the restrictions on the CDC and NIH that prohibit them from conducting any research on gun violence.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA). The City Administrative Officer has not completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At a special meeting held on January 13, 2016, the Rules, Elections, Intergovernmental Relations, and Neighborhoods Committee considered Resolution (Koretz - Krekorian) and a report from the CLA dated January 11, 2016 relative to establishing the City's position regarding legislation to lift restrictions on the CDC and NIH that prohibit them from conducting research on gun violence. The CLA report, attached to Council file No. 15-0002-S113, provides additional background information and a summary of the Resolution.

After consideration and after providing an opportunity for public comment, the Rules, Elections, Intergovernmental Relations, and Neighborhoods Committee recommended that Council adopt the Resolution. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
