RULES, ELECTIONS, INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS, AND NEIGHBORHOODS COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to establishing the City's position regarding AB 726 (Nazarian) regarding the operation of bi-Articulated Buses Along the Metro Orange Line.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Krekorian - Blumenfield), SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION to include in the City's 2015-16 State Legislative Program SUPPORT for AB 726 (Nazarian), which would authorize the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Metro) to operate articulated buses up to 82 feet on the Metro Orange Line in the San Fernando Valley.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Chief Legislative Analyst. The City Administrative Officer has not completed a financial analysis of this report.

SUMMARY

At its regular meeting held on Friday, August 21, 2015, the Rules, Elections, Intergovernmental Relations, and Neighborhoods Committee considered Resolution (Krekorian - Blumenfield) and a report from the CLA dated August 18, 2015 relative to establishing the City's position to support AB 726 (Nazarian), which would authorize Metro to operate articulated buses up to 82 feet on the Metro Orange Line in the San Fernando Valley.
