PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the payment of a Graffiti Apprehension Reward for the graffiti vandalism incident that occurred at 8600 North Sepulveda Boulevard.

Recommendations for Council action:

- 1. APPROVE the payment of a Graffiti Apprehension Reward in the amount of \$1,000 for the incident that occurred at 8600 North Sepulveda Boulevard on July 27, 2014.
- 2. AUTHORIZE the City Clerk to pay this claim from the Vandalism and Graffiti Trust Fund No. 870.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: None submitted by the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD). Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

In a report to Council dated March 10, 2015 (attached to the Council file), LAPD recommends payment of a Graffiti Apprehension Reward in the amount of \$1,000 for the graffiti vandalism incident that occurred at 8600 North Sepulveda Boulevard on July 27, 2014. LAPD states that the application for the reward was submitted after the defendant was arrested for graffiti vandalism of property within the City of Los Angeles. The applicant alerted the authorities after observing the subject's action. This resulted in the defendant being convicted and assigned to home on probation. At its meeting held June 26, 2015, the Public Safety Committee recommended that Council approve payment of this reward.
