The City of Los Angeles offers a reward payable at the discretion of the City Council to one or more persons in the sum or sums up to an aggregate maximum total sum of \$50,000 for information leading to the identification and apprehension of the person or persons responsible for the act of murder against, SUREN "CHRIS" DONOYAN, in the City of Los Angeles. On Sunday, November 23, 2014, Los Angeles Police Officers from the North Hollywood Division responded to an apartment in the 5400 block of Tujunga Avenue, where they found the body of Suren "Chris" Donoyan, a 53-year old male who had been shot in the head. The victim's body had been discovered by members of the Los Angeles Fire Department who had been contacted by the victim's family when he failed to respond to phone calls. Subsequent investigation revealed that the victim had most likely been murdered on the afternoon of November 20, 2014. Detectives are continuing to investigate this brutal murder, and hope that a monetary reward compels members of the public to provide more information. The person or persons responsible for this crime represent an ongoing threat to the safety of the people of Los Angeles. Unless withdrawn or paid by City Council action, this offer of reward shall terminate on, and have no effect after, OCTOBER 17, 2015.

The provisions of payment and all other considerations shall be governed by Chapter 12 of Division 19 of the LAAC Code, as amended by Ordinance Nos. 158157 and 166666. This offer shall be given upon the condition that all claimants provide continued cooperation within the criminal justice system relative to this case and is not available to public officers or employees of the City, their families, persons in law enforcement or persons whose misconduct prompted this reward. 

AVISO DE RECOMPENSA DE \$50,000

La Ciudad de Los Angeles ofrece una recompensa pagadera a la discreción del Concejo de la Ciudad a una o más personas por la suma o hasta una cantidad en conjunto de \$50,000 por información que conduzca a la identificación y detención de la persona o personas responsables por la muerte de SUREN "CHRIS" DONOYAN, en la Ciudad de Los Angeles. El domingo 23 de noviembre de 2014, los Oficiales de Policía de Los Angeles de la División de North Hollywood respondieron a un apartamento en la cuadra 5400 de Tujunga Avenue, donde encontraron el cuerpo de Suren "Chris" Donoyan, un hombre de 53 años de edad quien tenía un disparo en la cabeza. El cuerpo de la víctima había sido descubierto por los miembros del Departamento de Bomberos que habían sido contactados por la familia de la víctima cuando no respondió a las llamadas telefónicas. Investigación posterior reveló que la víctima había sido probablemente asesinada la tarde del 20 de noviembre de 2014. Los detectives continúan investigando este brutal asesinato, y esperan que una recompensa monetaria obligue a los miembros del público a proporcionar más información. La persona o personas responsables de este delito representan una amenaza constante para la seguridad de los habitantes de Los Angeles. A menos que se retire o se pague la acción por medio del Concejo de la Ciudad, esta oferta de recompensa terminará, y no tendrá ningún efecto posterior al 17 DE OCTUBRE DE 2015.
