\$50,000 REWARD NOTICE

The City of Los Angeles offers a reward payable at the discretion of the City Council to one or more persons in the sum or sums up to an aggregate maximum total sum of \$50,000 for information leading to the identification and apprehension of the person or persons responsible for the act of murder against, DONALD HEARD AND INJURIES TO PHILLIP CLARK, in the City of Los Angeles. On Wednesday September 17, 2014, at approximately 5:15 a.m., 54-year old Donald Heard and 61-year old Phillip Clark were shot at multiple times by an unknown individual using a semiautomatic handgun, as they were walking on Edgehill Drive at the intersection of West 27th Street in Los Angeles. Both Mr. Heard and Mr. Clark were struck by gunfire, with Mr. Heard being mortally wounded. Detectives are continuing to investigate this crime, but have not yet been able to identify the suspect. Detectives believe a reward may compel members of the public to provide information on the identity of the person responsible for this crime. The person or persons responsible for this crime represent an ongoing threat to the safety of the people of Los Angeles. Unless withdrawn or paid by City Council action, this offer of reward shall terminate on, and have no effect after, OCTOBER 30, 2015.

The provisions of payment and all other considerations shall be governed by Chapter 12 of Division 19 of the LAAC Code, as amended by Ordinance Nos. 158157 and 166666. This offer shall be given upon the condition that all claimants provide continued cooperation within the criminal justice system relative to this case and is not available to public officers or employees of the City, their families, persons in law enforcement or persons whose misconduct prompted this reward.
