On Sunday, June 21, 2015, at approximately 2:23 a.m., 21-year old Almicar Ponce and a friend were standing on the sidewalk in front of 4238 South Wall Street in Los Angeles, when two vehicles approached them from the direction of 43rd Street. As the vehicles approached, individuals in those vehicles fired numerous shots towards Mr. Ponce and his friend, and then fled north on Wall Street. Mr. Ponce was struck in the head, while his friend was able to drive for miles and remained unscathed. Fire department Paramedics transported Mr. Ponce to the hospital, where he succumbed to his injuries on June 26, 2015. Detectives are continuing to investigate this crime, but have not yet been able to identify the suspect. Detectives believe a reward may compel members of the public to provide information on the identity of the persons responsible for this crime. The person or persons responsible for this crime represent an ongoing threat to the safety of the people of Los Angeles. Unless withdrawn or paid by City Council action, this offer of reward shall terminate on, and have no effect after, FEBRUARY 21, 2016.

The provisions of payment and all other considerations shall be governed by Chapter 12 of Division 19 of the LAAC Code, as amended by Ordinance Nos. 138157 and 166666. **AVISO DE RECOMPENSA DE \$50,000**

El domingo 21 de junio de 2015, aproximadamente a las 2:23 a.m., Almicar Ponce de 21 años de edad y un amigo estaban parados en la acera enfrente del 4238 South Wall Street en Los Angeles, cuando dos vehículos se acercaron a ellos desde la dirección de 43rd Street. A medida que los vehículos se acercaron, individuos de esos vehículos hicieron numerosos disparos hacia el Sr. Ponce y su amigo, y luego huyeron hacia el norte en Wall Street. El Sr. Ponce fue impactado en la cabeza, mientras su amigo fue capaz de tirarse para cubrirse y permanecer ileso. Paramédicos del departamento de bomberos transportaron al Sr. Ponce al hospital, donde el sucumbió a sus heridas el 26 de junio del 2015. Los detectives continúan investigando este crimen, pero aún no han sido capaces de identificar a los sospechosos. Los detectives creen que una recompensa puede obligar a los miembros del público a proporcionar información para identificar a las personas responsables de este crimen. La persona o personas responsables de este delito representan una amenaza constante para la seguridad de los habitantes de Los Angeles. 
