\$50,000 REWARD NOTICE

The City of Los Angeles offers a reward payable at the discretion of the City Council to one or more persons in the sum or sums up to an aggregate maximum total sum of \$50,000 for information leading to the identification and apprehension of the person or persons responsible for the act of murder against, ANTONIA MARIA YAGER, in the City of Los Angeles. On Monday, December 22, 2014, at approximately 7:00 p.m., 86-year old Antonia Maria Yeager was found stabbed to death in the bedroom of her home, located in the Windsor Square neighborhood of Los Angeles. Ms. Yager had attended a charity dinner at the Wilshire Country Club the previous evening, and was last seen alive when she was dropped off by a friend at her home that night. Detectives have not determined a motive for this crime, but are not ruling out that Ms. Yager was the victim of a home invasion or a robbery. Detectives are continuing to investigate this crime, and believe that a reward may compel members of the public to provide information. The person or persons responsible for this crime represent an ongoing threat to the safety of the people of Los Angeles. Unless withdrawn or paid by City Council action, this offer of reward shall terminate on, and have no effect after, AUGUST 18, 2015.

The provisions of payment and all other considerations shall be governed by Chapter 12 of Division 19 of the LAAC Code, as amended by Ordinance Nos. 158157 and 166666. This offer shall be given upon the condition that all claimants provide continued cooperation within the criminal justice system relative to this case and is not available to public officers or employees of the City, their families, persons in law enforcement or persons whose misconduct prompted this reward. If you have any information regarding this case, please call the Los Angeles Police Department at 1-877-LAWFULL, 24 hours.

El lunes 22 de diciembre de 2014, aproximadamente a las 7:00 p.m., Antonia Maria Yeager de 86 años de edad fue encontrada muerta a puñaladas en el dormitorio de su casa ubicada en el barrio de Windsor Square de Los Angeles. La Sra. Yager había asistido a una cena benéfica en el Wiltshire Country Club la noche anterior, y le visitó por última vez con vida cuando fue dejada por un amigo en su casa esa noche. Los detectives no han determinado el motivo de este crimen, pero no se descarta que la Sra. Yager fuese víctima de un allanamiento de morada o un robo. Los detectives continúan investigando este crimen, y creen que una recompensa puede obligar a los miembros del público a proporcionar información. La persona o personas responsables de este delito representan una amenaza constante para la seguridad de los habitantes de Los Angeles. A menos que se retire o se pague la acción por medio del Concejo de la Ciudad, esta oferta de recompensa terminará, y no tendrá ningún efecto posterior al 18 DE AGOSTO DE 2015.
