During this fight, the driver of the SUV drove on to the sidewalk in an attempt to run down John Doe. John Doe ran off the sidewalk and onto Main Street in an attempt to avoid being hit, but the SUV reversed direction and accelerated in his direction, fatally striking him. Detectives have not yet been able to identify the suspects and are continuing to investigate this crime, and believe a reward may compel members of the public to provide information on the identity of the persons responsible for this crime. The person or persons responsible for this crime represent an ongoing threat to the safety of the people of Los Angeles. Unless withdrawn or paid by City Council action, this offer of reward shall terminate on, and have no effect after, SEPTEMBER 5, 2015. Durante esta pelea, el conductor de la SUV siguió conduciendo sobre la acera en un intento por frenar a John Doe. John Doe acabó bajando de la acera y salió a Main Street en un intento de evitar ser golpeado, pero la SUV cambió de dirección y aceleró en dirección a él, golpeándolo fatalmente. Los detectives aún no han sido capaces de identificar a los sospechosos y continúan investigando este crimen, y creemos una recompensa pueda obligar a los miembros del público a proporcionar información sobre la identidad de las personas responsables de este crimen. La persona o personas responsables de este delito representan una amenaza constante para la seguridad de los habitantes de Los Angeles.
