Recommendation for Council action:

APPROVE the exemption of one Assistant General Manager Recreation and Parks (Class Code 9241) position for the RAP from the Civil Service provisions of the City Charter pursuant to Charter Section 1001(b).

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the RAP. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.


Summary:

On June 19, 2019, your Committee considered a June 13, 2019 communication from the Mayor relative to the exemption of one Airports Manager III (Class Code 7260) position for the LAWA from the Civil Service provisions of the City Charter pursuant to Charter Section 1001(b). According to the Mayor, Charter Section 1001(b) allows up to 150 persons to be exempt, of which 141 are approved, with one other pending request. Approval of this request will increase the count. As of June 13, 2019, this request will be in the 147th position of the 150 exemptions. There are an additional 50 exempt positions added by the City Council pursuant to Charter Section 1001(b)(4), of which 12 are filled.

The Assistant General Manager will report directly to the General Manager, and be one of the four Assistant General Managers in the RAP. The position will be responsible for overseeing and managing the department's Planning, Construction and Maintenance Branch, which includes approximately 700 full-time and 500 part-time employees. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend approval of the exemption as detailed in the above recommendation. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
