The Lopez Canyon Community Amenities Trust Fund, provides funding for community amenities in the vicinity of the Lopez Canyon landfill within Council District 7.

The Public Works Office of Community Beautification is coordinating additional bulky item pickup, alley cleanup, and community beautification projects to be conducted by Sylmar Graffiti Busters and Northeast Graffiti Busters in CD 7.

Sufficient funds are available in the Lopez Canyon Community Amenities Trust Fund which could be used for this purpose.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Council RESOLVE that \$100,000 in the Lopez Canyon Landfill Community Amenities Trust Fund No. 531-14 be transferred/appropriated to the Board of Public Works Fund No. 100-74, Account No. 3040 (Contractual Services) to be allocated as follows for enhanced bulky item pickup, alley cleanup, and community beautification projects and services in Council District Seven: \$32,800 for Sylmar Graffiti Busters and \$67,200 for Northeast Graffiti Busters; and that the Public Works Office of Community Beautification be authorized to prepare the necessary document(s) with, and/or payment(s) to these organizations, in these amounts, and for the above purposes, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form, if needed; and that the Council member of the Seventh District be authorized to execute any such documents on behalf of the City.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Department of Public Works be authorized to make any corrections, clarifications or revisions to the above fund transfer instructions, including any new instructions, in order to effectuate the intent of this Motion, including any corrections and changes to fund or account numbers; said corrections / clarifications / changes may be made orally, electronically or by any other means.
