
The Miracle Mile Residential Association, a multi-purpose community organization composed of homeowners and renters, is actively interested in maintaining the quality of life, property values, security and positive image in the Miracle Mile area of Los Angeles through careful monitoring of and input on land use, zoning and neighborhood concerns.

Mos recently the Miracle Mile Residential Association is pursuing efforts to maintain the historic nature of its residential areas including limiting the size of new construction and remodeled homes and the creation of a Historic Preservation Overlay Zone [HPOZ] to protect the traditional and historical character of the neighborhood.

At this time the Association is exploring HPOZ protection for the Miracle Mile through fact-finding and input of residents and property owners. To this end the Association is funding consultant services to conduct the necessary analyses in support of historical designation.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Planning Department be directed to provide information and advice, on an as-needed basis, to assist the Miracle Mile Residential Association in its efforts to conduct through private consulting services the necessary analyses in support of Historic Preservation Overlay Zone designation in the Miracle Mile residential area bounded by Wilshire Boulevard on the North, San Vicente Boulevard on the South, LaBrea Avenue on the east and Fairfax Avenue on the west.
