

TRADE, COMMERCE, AND TOURISM COMMITTEE REPORT and ORDINANCE FIRST CONSIDERATION relative to authorizing the General Manager of the Harbor Department to enter into multi-year contracts that would otherwise require approval by the Board of Harbor Commissioners.

Recommendation for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

PRESENT and ADOPT the accompanying ORDINANCE amending Subsection (c) of Section 10.1.1 of Article 1, Chapter 1 of Division 10 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code to allow the Board of Harbor Commissioners to authorize the General Manager of the Harbor Department to enter into multi-year contracts, up to three years, that would otherwise require approval by the Board of Harbor Commissioners.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the City Attorney. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At a special meeting held on March 24, 2015, your Trade, Commerce and Tourism Committee considered a City Attorney report and Ordinance relative to authorizing the General Manager of the Harbor Department to enter into multi-year contracts that would otherwise require approval by the Board of Harbor Commissioners. An opportunity for public comment was held. After a brief discussion, the Committee moved to approve the Ordinance submitted by the City Attorney.
