PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the acceptance of the donation from the Los Angeles Police Foundation of monitors, hardware, software and related installation for Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) Robbery Homicide Division.

Recommendation for Council action:

ACCEPT the donation of monitors, hardware, software and related installation valued at \$94,290, from the Los Angeles Police Foundation for the benefit of the LAPD Robbery Homicide Division, and THANK the donor for this generous donation.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Board of Police Commissioners. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

In a report to the Board of Police Commissioners dated August 27, 2015, attached to the Council file, the LAPD recommends that the Board approve the acceptance of the donation from the Los Angeles Police Foundation of monitors, hardware, software and related installation for LAPD Robbery Homicide Division. The LAPD reports that the donation will benefit the LAPD by providing an upgrade to Robbery Homicide Division's Situation Room. Robbery Homicide Division investigates high-profile incidents that occur in the City. The ability to assemble, organize and deploy large numbers of investigators during a prolonged or multi-agency event is an integral part of the major case management strategy it employs. The donation will allow the Robbery Homicide Division to more efficiently display, disseminate, and act on pertinent information received from the public and other law enforcement agencies in real-time. After further discussion of the matter, the Committee recommended that Council approve the acceptance of the donation from the Los Angeles Police Foundation of monitors, hardware, software and related installation for LAPD Robbery Homicide Division, as recommended by the Board of Police Commissioners, as detailed above. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
