

COMMUNICATION FROM CHAIR AND MEMBER, PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE relative to a donation of excess military property for use by the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD).

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the LAPD to accept the donation of excess military property, valued at \$291,636.83, from the Department of Defense, Federal Excess Property 1033 Program, for use by the LAPD's Emergency Operations Division, and THANK the donor for this generous gift.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the LAPD. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

In a report to the Board of Police Commissioners dated February 13, 2015, LAPD requests authority to accept a donation of excess military property from the Department of Defense. The donation consists of 270 reflex sights, 1 surveying wheel, 389 small field packs, 37 large field packs, 231 entrenching tools, 73 sleeping mats, 219 mess kits, 3 Wii gaming consoles, 21 warm weather sleeping bags, 33 cold weather sleeping bags, 35 small craft boats, 226 commercial spikes, 6 general purpose containers, 2 rough terrain forklifts, and 6 cabinet lockers. The donated items will be distributed to various Department entities to enhance operational capabilities. On February 17, 2015, the Board approved LAPD's request.

At the Public Safety Committee meeting held May 8, 2015, the Committee Chair and Member recommended that Council authorize LAPD to accept this donation.
