

PERSONNEL AND ANIMAL WELFARE COMMITTEE REPORT and ORDINANCE FIRST CONSIDERATION relative to the establishment of the salary for the new class of Chief Information Security Officer.

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

1. PRESENT and ADOPT the accompanying ORDINANCE to establish the salary for the new class of Chief Information Security Officer, Range 6013 (\$125,551 - \$183,577).
2. AUTHORIZE the City Administrative Officer (CAO), upon accretion of the class to a bargaining unit, to amend the appropriate Memorandum of Understanding to reflect the salary approved by Ordinance.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The CAO reports that there is no fiscal impact on the City's General Fund as the entire salary cost for this position is the obligation of the Los Angeles World Airports (LAWA).

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On April 21, 2015, your Committee considered April 13, 2015 CAO and April 9, 2015 City Attorney reports and Ordinance relative to the establishment of the salary for the new class of Chief Information Security Officer. According to the CAO, on March 24, 2015, the Executive Employee Relations Committee approved the recommendation of the CAO to establish the salary for the new class of Chief Information Security Officer. This new class was adopted by the Civil Service Commission on September 11, 2014, to be responsible for the design, implementation, operation, and maintenance of all information security for the LAWA.

After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend approval of the Ordinance to establish the salary for the class of Chief Information Security Officer. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
