

RESOLUTION

**ESTABLISHMENT OF OVERSIZE VEHICLE RESTRICTED STREETS IN THE
MANCHESTER SQUARE AREA NEAR LA CIENEGA BLVD**

WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code Section 22507 authorizes cities to restrict the parking of vehicles, including but not limited to, vehicles that are six feet or more in height, on identified City streets, during certain hours; and

WHEREAS, the Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 80.69.4 allows the City Council to authorize by Resolution, the streets upon which the parking of oversize vehicles shall be restricted between 2:00 AM and 6:00 AM; and

WHEREAS, the community of Manchester Square is experiencing public safety issues associated with large vehicles which are parked overnight and constrict travel lanes on the following street segments, thereby creating undesirable roadway conditions, especially when it is dark:

- S. La Cienega Blvd between W. 98th Street and W. 95th Street
- W. 98th Street to S. La Cienega Blvd (Cul De Sac)
- W. 97th Street to S. La Cienega Blvd (Cul De Sac)
- Pardee Street to S. La Cienega Blvd (Cul De Sac)
- W. 95th Place to S. La Cienega Blvd (Cul De Sac)
- W. 95th Street to S. La Cienega Blvd. (Cul De Sac)

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council, pursuant to the Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 80.69.4, hereby prohibits the parking of vehicles that are in excess of 7 feet in height, or 22 feet in length, during the hours of 2:00 AM to 6:00 AM, at the following locations:

- S. La Cienega Blvd between W. 98th Street and W. 95th Street
- W. 98th Street to S. La Cienega Blvd (Cul De Sac)
- W. 97th Street to S. La Cienega Blvd (Cul De Sac)
- Pardee Street to S. La Cienega Blvd (Cul De Sac)
- W. 95th Place to S. La Cienega Blvd (Cul De Sac)
- W. 95th Street to S. La Cienega Blvd. (Cul De Sac)

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon the adoption of this Resolution, the Department of Transportation be directed to post signs giving notice of a “Tow Away, No Parking, Vehicles Over 7 Feet Tall or Over 22 Feet Long, 2:00 AM to 6:00 AM, Vehicles with Permits Exempted” restriction for oversized vehicles, at the above locations; and



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon adoption of this Resolution, that the Department of Transportation be directed to initiate the necessary procedures for the preparation and sale of overnight parking permits, as specified in Los Angeles Municipal Code section 80.69.4.(c); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation be authorized to make any technical corrections or clarifications to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.
