

COMMUNICATION FROM CHAIR, PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE relative to selection of Bruffy's, Inc., to serve as the Official Police Garage (OPG) for Los Angeles Police Department's (LAPD) Service Area 14 (Pacific Area).

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the President, Board of Police Commissioners, or designee, to negotiate and execute an OPG Towing and Storage agreement for Service Area 14 with Bruffy's, Inc., subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form and legality.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Board of Police Commissioners. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

In a report to the Board of Police Commissioners dated April 27, 2015, the Board's Executive Director recommends the approval of the selection of Bruffy's, Inc., to serve as the OPG for LAPD's Pacific Area. The report discusses the request for proposals and evaluation processes. Two proposals were submitted, one was disqualified. Commission staff awarded Bruffy's an average score of 82.3 based on formal business plan, experience, history of contract compliance, customer service, and honesty and integrity. The majority of Bruffy's tow equipment is in good working order. Bruffy's has served as an OPG for thirty-one years it also provides towing services to the Los Angeles Unified School District and the Los Angeles County Sheriffs Department. On May 5, 2015, the Board approved the selection of Bruffy's.

At the Public Safety Committee meeting held June 12, 2015, the Committee Chair recommended that Council authorize the Board of Police Commissioners to negotiate and execute an OPG Towing and Storage agreement for Service Area 14 with Bruffy's, Inc.
