An ordinance amending Ordinance No. 182982 (amending Section 4.61 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code for 2014-2015 to 2015-2016 Fiscal Year Salaries and Benefits) to provide a salary for the new, non-represented class of Staff Assistant to General Manager Harbor (Code 9212).

**THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance 182982 is amended to add the following:

<u>Code No.</u>	<u>Title</u>	<u>Salary Range No.</u>
9212	Staff Assistant to General Manager Harbor	6453

Sec. 2. Section 1 shall be operative upon publication.

Sec. 3. The City Administrative Officer and the Controller are authorized to correct any clerical errors or, if approved by the City Attorney, any technical errors in this Ordinance.

Sec. 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and have it published in accordance with Council policy, either in a daily newspaper circulated in the City of Los Angeles or by posting for ten days in three public places in the City of Los Angeles: one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall; one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall East; and one copy on the bulletin board located at the Temple Street entrance to the Los Angeles County Hall of Records.

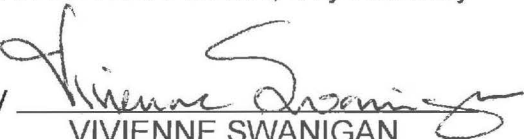
