

TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to prohibiting the parking of oversized vehicles in Del Rey.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Bonin - Blumenfield):

1. RESOLVE, pursuant to Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) Section 80.69.4, to hereby prohibit the parking of vehicles that are in excess of 22 feet in length or over 84 inches in height, during the hours of 2:00 AM and 6:00 AM, along the following streets:
  - a. Inglewood Boulevard from Hammack Street to Bray Street
  - b. Mesmer Avenue between Hammack Street and Beatrice Street
2. DIRECT the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT), upon approval of this action, to post signs giving notice of a Tow Away, No Parking restriction for oversized vehicles, with the specific hours detailed, along the streets as specified above in Recommendation No. 1.
3. AUTHORIZE the LADOT to make any technical corrections or clarifications to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this action.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On August 12, 2015, your Committee considered a Resolution (Bonin - Blumenfield) relative to prohibiting the parking of oversized vehicles in Del Rey and specifically, on the following streets:

- a. Inglewood Blvd. from Hammack St. to Bray Street
- b. Mesmer Ave. between Hammack Street and Beatrice Street

According to the Resolution, the above two streets are experiencing increased problems with oversized vehicles parking under the I-90 Freeway immediately adjacent to residential buildings in Council District 11; these large vehicles are often parked overnight and constrict travel lanes, thereby causing dangerous situations. LAMC Section 80.69.4 allows the City Council to authorize by Resolution the streets upon which the parking of oversize vehicles shall be restricted between the hours of 2:00 AM and 6:00 AM.

After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend adoption of the Resolution. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
