

## RESOLUTION

## ESTABLISHMENT OF OVERSIZE VEHICLE RESTRICTED STREETS IN DEL REY

WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code Section 22507 authorizes cities to restrict the parking of vehicles that are six feet or more in height on specific City streets during prescribed hours; and

WHEREAS, the Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 80.69.4 allows the Council to authorize by resolution, restricted parking of oversize vehicles between 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. on City streets; and

WHEREAS, the community of Del Rey is experiencing public safety issues associated with large vehicles that park for excessive periods of time on various streets;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council, pursuant to the Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 80.69.4, hereby prohibits the parking of vehicles that are in excess of 22 feet in length or over 84 inches in height, during the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. on both sides of the street at the following locations:

- Bonaparte Avenue between Mascagni Street and McConnell Avenue;
- Grand View between Greene Avenue and Gilmore Avenue;
- Greene Avenue between Grand View Boulevard and Lindblade Drive;
- McConnell Avenue between Bonaparte Avenue and Panama Street;
- Mascagni Street between Culver Boulevard and Short Avenue;
- Rubens Avenue between Mascagni Street and McConnell Avenue;
- Patrae Street between Milton Street and the dead end to the north;
- Walsh Avenue between Mascagni Street and Beethoven Street; and
- Inglewood Boulevard between Bray Street and Hammack Street.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon the adoption of the Resolution, the Department of Transportation be directed to post signs giving notice of a "tow away, no parking" restriction for oversized vehicles, with the specific hours detailed, at the above locations.


