

# RESOLUTION

## ESTABLISHMENT OF OVERSIZE VEHICLE RESTRICTED STREETS IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 12

WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code Section 22507 authorizes cities to restrict the parking of vehicles, including but not limited to, vehicles that are six feet or more in height, on identified City streets during certain hours; and

WHEREAS, the Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 80.69.4 allows the Council to authorize by resolution, the streets upon which the parking of oversize vehicles shall be restricted between 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m.; and

WHEREAS, Council District 12 is experiencing public safety issues associated with large vehicles that are parked overnight and block travel lanes, thereby creating hazardous conditions;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council, pursuant to the Los Angeles Municipal Codes Section 80.69.4, hereby prohibits the parking of vehicles that are in excess of 22 feet in length or over 84 inches in height, during the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m., within the boundaries of:

- Both sides of Platt Avenue between Victory Boulevard and Vanowen Street;
- The south side of Roscoe Boulevard between Valley Circle Boulevard and Lena Avenue;
- Both sides of the 6300 and 7000 block of Valley Circle Boulevard; and
- The south side of Sherman Way between Fallbrook Avenue and Shoup Avenue.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon the adoption of this Resolution, the Department of Transportation be directed to post signs giving notice of a "tow away, no parking" restriction for oversized vehicles, with the specific hours detailed, at the above locations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation be authorized to make technical corrections or clarifications to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.
