ARTS, PARKS, HEALTH, AGING AND RIVER COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the negotiation of an agreement with the National Park Service in regard to the Juan Bautista de Anza National Historic Trail to promote shared recreational and educational objectives.

Recommendations for Council action, as initiated by Motion (O'Farrell - LaBonge):

- INSTRUCT the City Engineer to negotiate a suitable agreement with the National Park Service relative to the Juan Bautista de Anza National Historic Trail along the Los Angeles River Trail to promote shared recreational and educational objectives, as further detailed in the text of the Motion, attached to the Council file, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form and legality.
- 2. INSTRUCT the City Engineer and all other affected entities to report to Council with a finalized agreement prior to execution to ensure that all respective Boards, if necessary, and outside entities affected, including, but not limited to, the County of Los Angeles, have been made aware of the agreement and all issues raised by their City or non-City entities have been addressed.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

At a special meeting on May 18, 2015, the Arts, Parks, Health, Aging and River Committee considered Motion (O'Farrell - LaBonge) relative to the negotiation of an agreement with the National Park Service in regard to the Juan Bautista de Anza National Historic Trail to promote shared recreational and educational objectives. During the discussion of this item, representatives from the Bureau of Engineering and the National Park Service provided an overview of the proposed agreement and history of the trail, and responded to various related questions from the Committee members.

After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended that Council approve the Motion as amended to reflect the above recommendations. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
