Honorable Members:

Pursuant to your request, this Office has prepared and now transmits for your consideration the enclosed draft ordinance, approved as to form and legality. The draft ordinance amends Section 63.44(B)(14)(c) of the Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) by adding Alma Park to the list of City parks that close at sunset and open at sunrise.

Background and Summary of Ordinance Provision

Currently, Alma Park, located at the intersection of West 21st Street and South Meyler Street in San Pedro, is closed between the hours of 10:30 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. of the following day, pursuant to LAMC Section 63.44(B)(14)(a).

On June 8, 2015, the City Council's Arts, Parks, Health, Aging and River (APHA) Committee requested this Office to prepare and present an ordinance adding Alma Park to the list of parks in LAMC Section 63.44(B)(14)(c) that close at sunset and open at sunrise the following day.

On June 17, 2015, the City Council adopted APHA's report requesting this Office to draft and present an ordinance adding Alma Park to the list of City parks that close at sunset and open at sunrise.

Council Rule 38 Referral

Copies of the draft ordinance were sent, pursuant to Council Rule 38, to the Department of Recreation and Parks and the Los Angeles Police Department requesting that all comments, if any, be presented directly to the City Council when this matter is considered.
