Subject: Rescission and Re-adoption of the Mobility Plan 2035

On August 11, 2015, the City adopted a progressive, forward-thinking, and balanced plan to address transportation issues. The Mobility Plan 2035 is a component of the City's General Plan and a comprehensive revision of the 1999 Transportation Element. It provides a policy framework to create a vision of a future transportation system that is safe, accessible, equitable and considers a range of transportation options.

On May 28, 2015, the City Planning Commission (CPC) considered and recommended approval of the draft Mobility Plan 2035. On June 5, 2015, the Mayor concurred with the CPC's recommendation. On August 11, 2015, under Council File No. 15-0719, the City Council adopted a resolution adopting the Mobility Plan 2035 as a component of the City's General Plan, subject to Council-initiated amendments. Council approved three amendments to the Mobility Plan 2035 and referred the other amending motions to the Planning and Land Use Management and Transportation Committees.

Staff recommends that Council rescind the August 11, 2015 resolution adopting the Mobility Plan 2035, which incorporated the Council-initiated amendments, and simultaneously adopt a resolution adopting the draft Mobility Plan 2035 as recommended for approval by both the CPC and the Mayor.

Requested Actions:

1. Rescind the August 11, 2015 resolution adopting the Mobility Plan 2035 as amended by the City Council.
2. Adopt a resolution (Exhibit A) adopting the Mobility Plan 2035 as considered and recommended by the City Planning Commission on May 28, 2015, and the Mayor on June 5, 2015.

3. Determine that the Final Environmental Impact Report in Case No. ENV-2013-0911-EIR, certified on August 11, 2015, assessed the adoption of the Mobility Plan 2035 as recommended by the CPC and the Mayor, and that no subsequent environmental impact report or negative declaration is required pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15162.
