We declare that on March 3, 2015, a Brown Act noticed public meeting was held by the Eagle Rock Neighborhood Council (ERNC) at which a quorum was present, and the following motion was passed unanimously (18-0):

The ERNC supports the goals of the City of Los Angeles 2035 Mobility Plan, as described in the Recirculated Draft EIR and supporting materials, including the implementation of a system of Complete Streets that “expands the role of the street as a public place,” and “ensures high-quality pedestrian access, provides a slow speed network of locally serving streets, improves the performance and reliability of existing and future bus service, provides safe, convenient and comfortable bicycling facilities and provides reliable vehicular access to the regional freeway system.”

On behalf of the Stakeholders of Eagle Rock, we recommend that the City enact the proposed General Plan Amendment for the Mobility Plan 2035. In addition, we encourage the City to include in its final Five Year Implementation Strategy the completion of New and Continuing programs in Eagle Rock, a neighborhood of Los Angeles that has proven to be uniquely supportive of innovative ideas and Complete Streets principles.
