MOTION

There is a great need to augment bulky item pickup, alley and commercial corridor cleanup, and community beautification projects in Council District 14. This effort is of special benefit for the residents of the City and for CD-14 and deserves financial assistance from the City. Sufficient funds are available for this purpose in the CD-14 Central Los Angeles Recycling and Transfer Station (CLARTS) Community Amenities Trust Fund.

I THEREFORE MOVE that \$199,000 in the Central Los Angeles Recycling and Transfer Station (CLARTS) Community Amenities Trust Fund No. 47S, Department 14, be transferred to the Board of Public Works Fund 100, Dept. 74, Account 3040 (Contractual Services) to be allocated in Fiscal Year 15-16 for community beautification efforts in Council District 14.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Board of Public Works, Office of Community Beautification be authorized to prepare the necessary documents and payments for the above services, and make any technical corrections or clarifications as necessary to the above fund transfer instruction in order to effectuate the intent of this Motion.
