At its meeting of July 16, 2015 the Board of Airport Commissioners acted to approve a Non-Exclusive License Agreement (NELA) covering Transportation Network Companies (TNCs) serving Los Angeles International Airport (LAX). This decision impacts a variety of stakeholders, and its effects will be felt in communities citywide. The Agreement will more than likely set a precedent for airports nationwide. If the NELA is ultimately ratified, LAX would become the largest airport in the country to allow TNCs to operate.

This NELA touched on numerous issues including geo-fencing, staging areas, and trip fees, but significant questions remain relative to the propriety of mandating background checks, clean fleet requirements, non-discrimination and equality of access, etc. It is the responsibility of the City Council and the Trade, Commerce, and Technology Committee to carefully consider such issues of importance to the public, so it is appropriate to review the Board's decision.

I THEREFORE MOVE that pursuant to Section 245 of the Los Angeles City Charter, the City Council assert jurisdiction over the July 16, 2015 decision of the Board of Airport Commissioners in relation to approving a Non-Exclusive License Agreement covering Transportation Network Company services to and from Los Angeles International Airport.
