REQUEST the City Attorney to report in 30 days on the feasibility and enforceability of exercising the City's authority to its fullest extent under all applicable law, including California Public Utilities Code section 5371.4, to produce an ordinance, to become effective no later than July 1, 2016, that would require that any transit provider, such as a charter-party carrier, including a limousine or shuttle service, Transportation Network Company, or taxicab, or any combination of those providers, which seeks to accept requests for rides in Los Angeles, to scrutinize their drivers using a fingerprint-based background check.
