

M O T I O N

In December 2014, Blue Shield of California Foundation awarded the Violence Prevention Coalition of Greater Los Angeles a grant addressing the relationship between domestic violence and gang violence. This grant provides \$5000.00 for the City Attorney's Office to act as a consultant in order to: 1) to assist in the development a 60-90 minute training curriculum to explain the domestic violence/gang violence connection; 2) to assist in the effort to collect data regarding the domestic violence/gang violence connection, and 3) to edit and contribute to a "white paper" on the connection of domestic violence to gang violence. Other partners in the grant include domestic violence and gang intervention agencies, including Peace Over Violence and Glendale YWCA, PCITI and Communities in Schools. The grant runs from December 2014 through August 2015.

The grant award to the City Attorney's Office of \$5,000.00 will be used to support the time spent by the City Attorney's Office, in consultation with the Violence Prevention Coalition and other grantees, to complete the deliverables set forth above. As this is a reimbursement of already funded staff salary, the grant is a reimbursement to the general fund.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Council, subject to the approval of the Mayor, AUTHORIZE the City Attorney to accept funding in the amount of \$5000.00 from the Violence Prevention Coalition of Greater Los Angeles for the City Attorney's participation in the Domestic Violence/Gang Violence grant from Blue Shield Foundation of California and INSTRUCT the Controller to deposit the funds in Fund 100, Dept 12, Revenue Source Code 5301 - Reimbursement from Other Funds.


