Comments for Public Posting: As a resident of the affected district, I am against this scheme to give away our communities to billionaire developers and mega-event promoters. Specifically, the LAART gondola project will have adverse effects on the surrounding neighborhood for decades to come. Not only will it involve the construction of huge towers on public land, but Historic Union Station, Chinatown, the Elysian Park neighborhoods, and the commuters on the Harbor/Pasadena Freeway will have cabins the size of shipping containers flying over them. Construction of the gondola could also clog up traffic in the neighborhoods surrounding Dodger Stadium for years. Angelenos have different priorities than a gondola. We want safe and affordable public transportation, more affordable housing, and a solution to the homeless crisis.
