We strongly urge this body to consider requesting a report back instead of directing DCP to draft an ordinance that would remove all zoning regulations to expedite Olympics related development and infrastructure that is both temporary AND permanent.

We need to first understand the universe of projects that would be expedited under such a provision and the unintended short and long term consequences upon our communities that this might impose. We also would like clarity on how a project may potentially be reclassified as an Olympics related project seeking to bypass regulations meant to safeguard communities.
