I MOVE that the matter of the AD HOC COMMITTEE ON THE 2028 OLYMPIC AND PARALYMPIC GAMES REPORT in regards to the STATUTORY EXEMPTION, PLANNING AND LAND USE MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT AND AD HOC COMMITTEE ON THE 2028 OLYMPIC AND PARALYMPIC GAMES REPORT relative to amending the Los Angeles Municipal Code to exempt certain 2028 Olympic and Paralympic Games (Games) related projects from planning and zoning requirements of the City's Zoning Code in preparation for the Games, item 11 on today's Council agenda (C.F.15-0989-S47), BE AMENDED to ADOPT the following additional recommendation reflected in bold:

- 7. AMEND Page Number 10, Section 1.7.1.F.2.c of the proposed Draft Ordinance dated January 8, 2026, attached to the LACPC report dated January 8, 2026, attached to Council the file, respectively, to read as follows:

c. For all lots containing one or more dwelling units that have an applied Residential Use District (Div. 5B.3.) or Residential Mixed Use District (Div. 5B.4.), or lots that are adjoining lots with these applied Use Districts and that contain one or more dwelling units, or lots that are adjoining lots that are zoned residential under Chapter I that contain a residential building, no digital display shall be arranged and illuminated in a manner that will produce a light intensity of greater than three foot candles above ambient lighting, as measured at the property line of the nearest lot with the aforementioned Use Districts/dwelling units. **Digital displays in locations as identified in this section shall have hours of operation from 7:00 am to 10:00 pm.**

Amend the proposed Draft Ordinance page number 4, Section 12.22 A.40(f)
(2)(iii), to read as follows:

(iii) For all residential zones with a residential building, or lots adjacent to a residential zone with a residential building, or lots adjacent to a Residential Use District (Div. 5B.3.), Residential-Mixed Use District (Div. 5B.4.) with one or more dwelling units unit under Chapter 1A, no Digital Display shall be arranged and illuminated in a manner that will produce a light intensity of greater than three foot candles above ambient lighting, as measured at the property line of the nearest lot with the aforementioned zone/residential building or Use Districts/dwelling units under Chapter 1A. Digital Displays in locations as identified in this section shall have hours of operation from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
