


AMENDING MOTION

I MOVE that Item 11 on today's Council Agenda, Council File 25-0662, Statutory Exemption, Planning and Land Use Management Committee report and Ad Hoc Committee on the 2028 Olympic and Paralympic Games Report relative to amending the Los Angeles Municipal Code to exempt certain 2028 Olympic and Paralympic Games (Games) related projects from planning and zoning requirements of the City's Zoning Code in preparation for the Games, be AMENDED to add the following recommendations:

1. A clause stating that no construction, installation, electrification, or conversion of any sign structure from static to digital may commence until all necessary departmental sign-offs have been finalized;
**14 day*
2. Include a **shot-clock*" provision to mandate a set decision timeline for permit applications. Forcing a timely decision helps official Olympic partners establish operations quickly, thereby allowing City resources to be redirected toward identifying and punishing illegal operators. **and report on possible consequences if the 14 days is not adhered to, for example deemed approved.*
3. Explicitly prohibit the issuance of any sign-offs or permit under this Ordinance to any off-site advertising/promotional company or property owner that is currently operating, or facilitating the operation of, illegal digital signage, of any type, anywhere within the City limits.
