

RESOLUTION

ESTABLISHMENT OF OVERSIZE VEHICLE RESTRICTED STREETS IN THE VENICE AREA ON ELECTRIC AVE BETWEEN MILWOOD AVE AND PALMS BLVD

WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code Section 22507 authorizes cities to restrict the parking of vehicles, including but not limited to, vehicles that are six feet or more in height, on identified City streets, during certain hours; and

WHEREAS, the Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 80.69.4 allows the City Council to authorize by Resolution, the streets upon which the parking of oversize vehicles shall be restricted between 2:00 AM and 6:00 AM; and

WHEREAS, the Venice community is experiencing public safety issues associated with large vehicles that are parked overnight and constrict travel lanes on the following street segment, thereby creating undesirable roadway conditions, especially when it is dark:

- Electric Ave between Milwood Ave. and Palms Blvd.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council, pursuant to the Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 80.69.4, hereby prohibits the parking of vehicles that are in excess of 7 feet in height, or 22 feet in length, during the hours of 2:00 AM to 6:00 PM, on both sides of the following street segment:

- Electric Ave between Milwood. Ave and Palms Blvd.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon the adoption of this Resolution, the Department of Transportation be directed to post signs giving notice of a "Tow Away, No Parking, Vehicles Over 7 Feet Tall or Over 22 Feet Long, 2:00 AM to 6:00 AM, Vehicles with Permits Exempted" restriction for oversized vehicles on both sides of the street, at the above locations; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon adoption of this Resolution, that the Department of Transportation be directed to initiate the necessary procedures for the preparation and sale of overnight parking permits, as specified in Los Angeles Municipal Code section 80.69.4.(c); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation be authorized to make any technical corrections or clarifications to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.
