

PUBLIC WORKS AND GANG REDUCTION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to naming the intersection of West 29th Street and Orchard Avenue as Dr. E. Wayne Gaddis, Sr. Square.

Recommendations for Council action, as initiated by Motion (Price – Ryu):

1. APPROVE the naming of the intersection of West 29th Street and Orchard Avenue as Dr. E. Wayne Gaddis, Sr. Square.
2. DIRECT the Los Angeles Department of Transportation to fabricate and install permanent ceremonial signs at this location, in consultation with Council District Nine.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

On October 6, 2015, Council considered Motion (Price – Ryu) relative to naming the intersection of West 29th Street and Orchard Avenue as Dr. E. Wayne Gaddis, Sr. Square. Motion states that Dr. Gaddis has served more than thirty years as a pastor, with leadership that is positive, productive, and progressive. Beyond his many pastoral accomplishments and academic credentials, he genuinely loves people and is a tender shepherd who takes his calling seriously to serve all people. In recognition of Dr. Gaddis, Sr.'s many years of service, vision, and dedication to the people of Los Angeles, Motion movers recommend that the intersection of West 29th Street and Orchard Avenue be designated Dr. E. Wayne Gaddis, Sr. Square. Council referred Motion to the Public Works and Gang Reduction Committee for consideration.
