Honorable Members:

This Office has prepared and transmits for your consideration the two enclosed draft ordinances, approved as to form and legality, relating to the lease financing referred to as the Municipal Improvement Corporation of Los Angeles (MICLA) Lease Revenue Bonds, Series 2025-A (Los Angeles Convention Center) and Lease Revenue Bonds, Series 2025-B (Los Angeles Convention Center) (Federally Taxable) (Bonds). The Bonds are proposed to be issued by MICLA to finance and refinance the costs of the expansion and modernization of, and improvements to, the Los Angeles Convention Center (Project), including retiring certain commercial paper notes issued by MICLA to finance costs of the Project.

The first draft ordinance, in connection with the issuance of the Bonds, approves the lease and sublease of certain real properties by the City, as lessor and sublessee, to and from MICLA, as lessee and sublessor, to pay principal of and interest on the Bonds.

The second draft ordinance creates two new special funds in the Los Angeles Administrative Code to receive, invest, and expend proceeds of the Bonds and record certain accounting transactions related to the Bonds.
