PERSONNEL AND HIRING

The Los Angeles Convention Center (LACC) is a vital economic engine for the City, generating significant tourism revenue, supporting thousands of local jobs, and serving as a key venue for international events. As the City moves forward with the approved LACC Expansion and Modernization Project, staffing and hiring efforts must remain on track to ensure successful and timely delivery.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the City Council instruct the City Administrative Officer (CAO) and Personnel Department, with support from the Bureau of Engineering (BOE) and the Chief Tourism Officer, and any other relevant department, provide a verbal update at the next regular Personnel & Hiring Committee meeting on the status of hiring for all positions authorized for the LACC Expansion and Modernization Project (Council File 15-1207-S1). The update should include a summary of hiring progress, any known delays, and how the staffing plan aligns with the pending Mayoral Executive Directive related to streamlining coordination for the Project.
