 - b. Provide a verbal update at the next regular Personnel and Hiring Committee meeting on the status of hiring for all positions authorized in the hiring plan for the LACC Expansion and Modernization Project (Council File No. 15-1207-S1) that have not been filled or have pending hires.
- DIRECT and CLARIFY that the CAO will act in coordination with the Chief Legislative Analyst in connection with the LACC Expansion and Modernization Project.

On October 24, 2025, your Committee considered a Motion (McOsker – Jurado) relative to hiring status in connection with the LACC Expansion and Modernization Project.
