

TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the Special Parking Revenue Fund (SPRF) Five-Year Operations and Maintenance Plan for metered parking and parking facilities programs for Fiscal Years (FY) 2017-18 through 2021-22.

Recommendation for Council action:

RECEIVE and FILE the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT) report dated July 31, 2018 relative to the SPRF Five-Year Operations and Maintenance Plan for metered parking and parking facilities programs for FYs 2017-18 through 2021-22.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Not applicable.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

In a report to Council dated July 31, 2018, LADOT discusses the SPRF. The SPRF is a special fund for the deposit of all revenue collected from parking meters and public off-street parking facilities administered by the Department. SPRF funds the operation and maintenance, capital expenses, and technological investments in the Department's Bureau of Parking Management. LADOT reports that total SPRF revenue and transfers to the General Fund are falling. The decrease in actual and projected revenue is attributed not charging for after-hour parking, fewer metered spaces and parking facilities, the proliferation of disabled parking placards, and illegal valet parking operations. The Department discusses these matters in greater detail and presents potential policy options to address them.

At its meeting held August 8, 2018, the Transportation Committee discussed this matter with LADOT staff. Department staff reviewed the report and its findings. The Committee Chair requested LADOT to further investigate illegal valet parking operations, and to identify City parking lots eligible for safe parking at night for homeless persons. Committee recommended that Council receive and file LADOT's report.
