

MOTION

The General City Purposes (GCP) portion of the 2015-2016 City Budget provides funds to assist local neighborhood programs, services and needs in each Council District.

Recycled Resources is a nonprofit volunteer-driven organization providing services for the homeless population in North East Los Angeles. Among its programs is a temporary shelter in Highland Park, operating since December 1 to protect individuals against inclement weather. These efforts have been supported by the Eagle Rock Neighborhood Council and the Historic Highland Park Neighborhood Council, along with numerous private individuals and business partners. This effort is of special benefit for the residents of the City and for CD-14 and deserves financial assistance.

Sufficient funds are available in the CD-14 portion of the Community Services line item in the General City Purposes budget for this purpose.

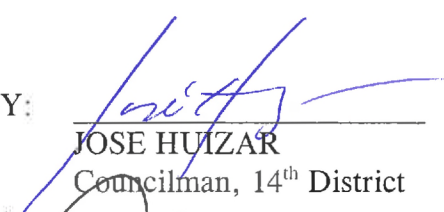
I THEREFORE MOVE that the Council determine, as provided in Section 54954.2(b)(2) of the Government Code, and pursuant to **Rule 23** of the Rules of the City Council, that there is a need to take immediate action on this matter AND that the need for action came to the attention of the City Council subsequent to the posting of the agenda for today's Council meeting.

I FURTHER MOVE that \$20,000 in the General City Purposes Fund No. 100-56, Account No. 0714 (CD-14 Community Services) be allocated to Recycled Resources for any aspect of their services to the homeless, including winter shelters and any general operating expenses.

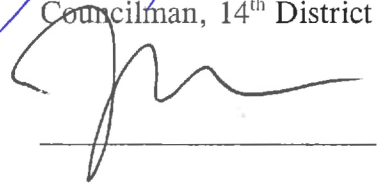
I FURTHER MOVE that the City Clerk be directed to prepare the necessary document(s) with, and/or payment(s) to Recycled Resources, or any other agency or organization, as appropriate, in the above amount, for the above purpose, subject to the approval of the City Attorney, if needed; and that the Council member of the District be authorized to execute any such documents on behalf of the City.

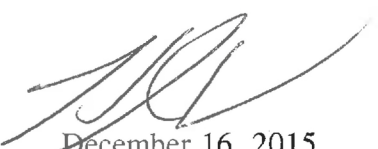
I FURTHER MOVE that the City Clerk be authorized to make any technical corrections or clarifications to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this Motion.
