Dear Honorable Council Members:


I am pleased to submit to you the Los Angeles International Airport (LAX) Master Plan 2014 Annual Progress Reports. In accordance with the LAX Specific Plan, Los Angeles World Airports (LAWA) is required to prepare and submit the Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program (MMRP), Traffic Generation, and Aviation Activity Analysis annual reports to you, our Board of Airport Commissioners, the Department of City Planning, and the Los Angeles Department of Transportation. Some achievements for the year include:

- Worked with Inglewood Unified School District to develop their First Work Plan to sound attenuate schools in their district
- Authorized \$10M for the Second Work Plan to sound attenuate schools in the Lennox School District
- Recycled a total of 155,383 tons of concrete on Master Plan projects
- Reduced vehicle emissions by over 7,000 tons and operated a FlyAway network averaging daily ridership of 4,300 passengers
- Completed restoration of 17.2 habitat units associated with the South Airfield Improvement Project

In keeping with LAWA's sustainability goals, we provide limited hard copies of the reports, as required, and make them available on LAWA's website located at www.ourlax.com.

As the LAX Master Plan Program moves forward, LAWA will continue to implement applicable provisions of the MMRP and to report on progress as needed.
