

PROTEST THE LADWP WATER RATE INCREASE!

Why we oppose the five-year rate increase:

- According to the LADWP's own benchmarking study **and** a review by the ratepayer advocate **and** an independent study, LADWP salaries and benefits are higher than comparable utilities, higher than comparable jobs for L.A. City, and higher than comparable jobs across the nation, yet nothing is being done about it except calls for more studies—while LADWP plans a “cost-of-living” raise in 2016.
- The new water rate ordinance lifts the cap that limits the extra charges for “adjustment factors,” which raise your rates in-between the other rate increases. These extra charges will now be unlimited, and they can be increased over and over, without City Council approval.

Subject: Proposed Rate increases DWP

The proposed rate increases continue to show a weakness in the city government by the City Council and their Dependence on the votes of the DWP unions.

Significant savings could be made in the costs related to the need for increases in several important areas.

1. Proper control of water pressure in AGING pipelines. The DWP is doing, and has done a terrible job of maintaining proper pressures in the pipe systems most prone to failure. This is due to the lack of proper inspection and supervision of the inspections, adjustment and repair to the many pressure stations. Pipe sections that inspections show a propensity to fail show be adjusted so that they would always have a lower operating pressure. The Metropolitan Water district does a highly superior job and has almost no failures. This can be verified off the record with the MWD supervisors. Their Comment: the DWP is doing the work sitting in their trucks.
2. Proper supervision and allocation of Man Power. Retired DWP people can testify to this as well as any trained observer will agree. Safety is one thing, Sloth and Lazy is another.
3. Pay and seniority systems: As DWP engineers get paid a significantly higher rate, other engineers (in many cases unqualified) move to the DWP from other Departments. Often doing public relations jobs at great expense..
4. Organization of the Energy rebate programs and proper training of the unqualified people as well as some continuity as they are here today, gone tomorrow.
5. Proper administrative work by qualified people to stop the tremendous waste and black eyes caused by computer systems that do not work. There is no accountability. Someone should be sued over the billing fiasco.



City, and higher than comparable jobs across the nation, yet nothing is being done about it except calls for more studies—while LADWP plans a “cost-of-living” raise in 2016.
- The new water rate ordinance lifts the cap that limits the extra charges for “adjustment factors,” which raise your rates in-between the other rate increases. These extra charges will now be unlimited, and they can be increased over and over, without City Council approval.


