

Notice of Hearing for Proposed Water Rate Restructure and Increases for the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power

On Wednesday, February 17, 2016, at 10:00 AM, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, the Los Angeles City Council is scheduled to hold a public hearing in the John Ferraro Council Chamber, Room 340, City Hall, 200 North Spring Street, Los Angeles, CA 90012. This will be a public hearing before the City Council to allow public testimony and discussion of the proposed restructured water rate ordinance and increases of the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP) water rates. The City Council will take and consider written and oral comments, including all written protests against the proposed charges, as required by Article XIII D, Section 6, of the California Constitution, determine if a majority protest exists, and consider whether to approve the proposed Water Rate Ordinance. Oral protests at the public hearing will not qualify as a protest, unless accompanied by a written protest. This notice is being sent to the owner of record of each parcel in LADWP's service area and to all LADWP water service customers. If neither you nor your property receive LADWP water service, this notice does not apply to you.

Written protests to the proposed rate changes may be submitted at the public hearing or delivered in person or mailed to the City Clerk, 200 North Spring Street, Room 395, Los Angeles, CA 90012, in time sufficient to be received prior to the close of the public hearing. A valid protest must include: the name of the owner or customer of record, the parcel address, and a statement of protest (“I/we protest” will suffice). Please also write “LADWP Water Rate Ordinance” on your written protest. Email protests will not be accepted. Please note each customer of record on the same account will be counted as a single vote, regardless of the number of persons listed on the application for water service. Only one written protest per parcel will be counted. If a majority protest exists, the applicable proposed rate changes will not be imposed.

Parking is available in private lots surrounding City Hall, and City Hall is accessible by public transportation. As a covered entity under Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act, the City of Los Angeles does not discriminate on the basis of disability and, upon request, will provide reasonable accommodation to ensure equal access to its programs, services and activities.



I Jacob, T. Puffer, am owner of the parcel at 2825 8th Ave. Los Angeles, CA 90018

I protest to the proposed Water Rate Structure on the following basis:

- The current cost of basic utilities for a middle class family is already difficult and the burden is too high on middle income families.
- The information provided to residents via mail email and Twitter regarding the rate increase - specifically how Los Angeles rates compared to neighboring cities and regions was misleading. The graphs' titles and captions suggested they were comparing the *rates* across the different areas when the data actually showed *average bill size* - not controlled for external factors like the portion of residents billed in apartments and condominiums. The average bill is not the same or similar to the water rate and should not been characterized as such. (see http://www.myladwp.com/see_how_we_are_keeping_our_rates_affordable_for_you?recruiter_id=7676 and http://www.myladwp.com/?utm_campaign=email1group9&utm_medium=email&utm_source=ladwp) Since the data provided was misleading, residents were not given ample opportunity to evaluate the rate increases fairly.

Please consider halting the current proposal. any new increase proposals should use fair and accurate campaign materials and adequate information. Any proposal should also shift more of the burden of the infrastructure costs to the heaviest users and away from struggling families.

My husband, James Gleason, and I reside at our home that we own at 5932 Beckford Avenue, Tarzana, CA 91356 which we have owned for 17 years. Much to our dismay our LADWP charges have escalated out of control in these past few years. Our water bills in particular have doubled or more in the last few years. We even put in drought tolerant landscaping in both our front and backyards after removing the grass. We removed the sprinkler system and put in a drip system. Still our water bill remains terribly high – at times much higher than before we took out our lawn and sprinkler system. We have had everything examined in and out of our home and there are no water leaks. The only thing responsible for our higher bills is greed on the part of the water company as far as we are concerned.

To raise our bills in the coming years at such an exorbitant rate is simply wrong and immoral. It is difficult to want to remain living in this city with the utilities and water rates being raised to such unreasonable heights every time we blink. But we love this city and living here and do not want to be forced to leave. In fact, many of our friends have left Los Angeles (and in fact California in many cases) citing the high cost of living and the LADWP charges in particular.

If the reason for the rate hike is to put the infrastructure in good repair perhaps you should look to the management of the Water Department and fixing and improving management before asking the homeowners to shoulder all of the responsibility for fixing things. The rate hike proposed is unreasonable. The LADWP Water Rate Ordinance and the high rate hike proposed makes living here, particularly for "senior citizens" on fixed incomes nearly impossible. 



Dear members of the Los Angeles City Council, **C. F. 15-1543**

I protest this proposed rate increase. I currently receive an electric rate PCAD discount due to my wife's health condition. A rate increase will result in a serious hardship for us.

I realize the importance of maintaining the city's water supply system. I am also aware of the water wasted and the public disruption caused by broken water mains that have not been properly maintained. However, it is wrong to raise our LADWP expenses to pay for this past negligence when other options exist to fund necessary repairs and improvements.

- A portion of any Federal funds allocated to help drought-stricken Southern California cope with that problem could logically be used to help pay for some LADWP capital expenses. As a major port city for international trade, the health and well-being of our citizens is important to our nation.
- Consider selling all unproductive real and personal property owned by the LADWP on the open market. Raise cash and put real estate back into the property tax paying category.
- Review existing scheduled replacement practices for LADWP vehicles and other equipment and machinery to lengthen those intervals. Of course safety concerns and higher maintenance costs must be taken into account.
- Call existing high-yield bonds, if callable, and issue new lower-yield bonds.
- Review compensation rates of LADWP employees at all levels to determine whether or not they are in line with similar positions in other companies; not just utilities. Make appropriate adjustments over a reasonable period of time; not abruptly.
- Encourage LADWP employees to participate in cost-lowering programs. Beware of such programs that offer financial rewards; they inevitably lead to ill-will and allegations of theft of one's idea.
- Give each LADWP Department Head an arbitrary X percentage budget cost reduction mandate. At the highest level, they cannot know for certain which departments are fat and which are lean. But, in a very short time, they will become aware of which departments require additional funding.
